Christmas sheep

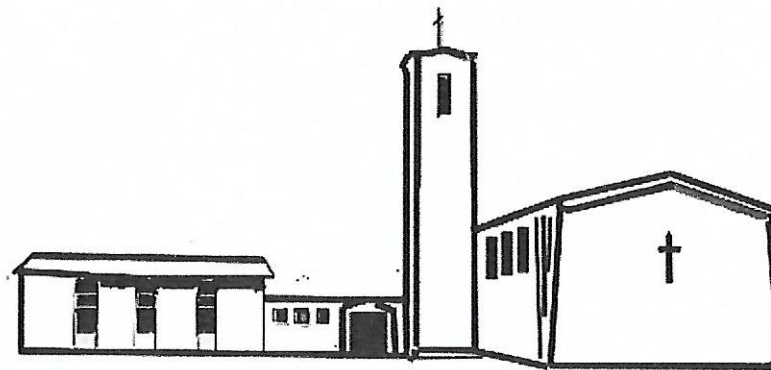
Knitting continues, 1000 sheep have already been made to
